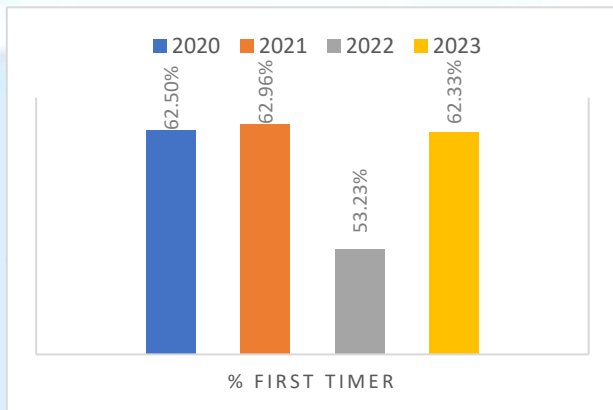

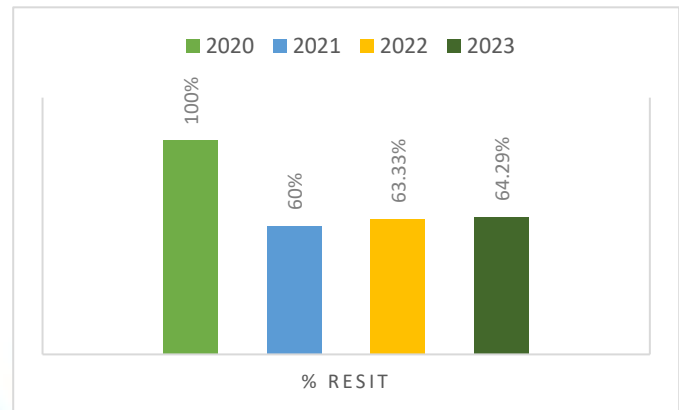

Graph 2: Operational Level % of Passers (Resit)



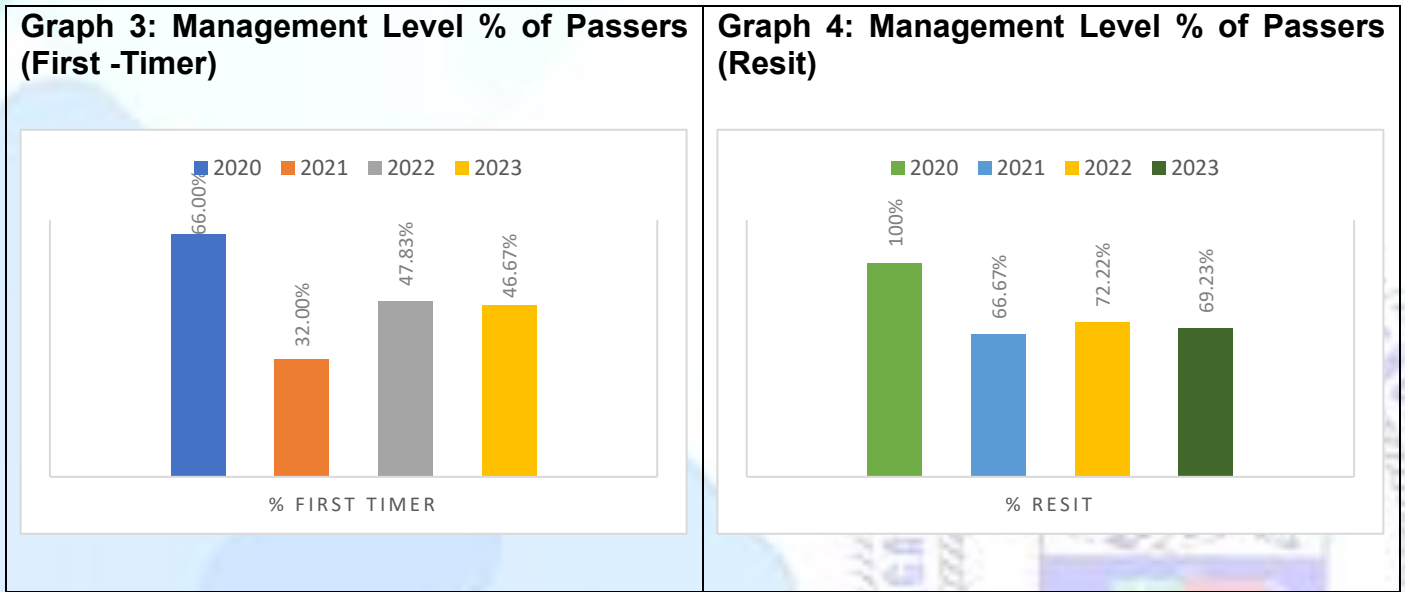

Licensure Exam Results for Operational Level

The BSMARE program has built a solid training foundation, consistently achieving a first-time examinee pass rate of over 50% from 2020 to 2023. The number of first-time examinees grew from 8 in 2020 to 77 in 2023, with an overall pass rate of 59.19%. Retake examinees also increased from 3 to 28, with a higher overall pass rate of 73.02%. Despite a drop in the first-time pass rate to 53.23% in 2022, the program recovered in 2023 with a pass rate of 62.33%. Retake examinees consistently outperformed first-timers, with pass rates rising from 60% in 2021 to

64.29% in 2023, reflecting strong support for these candidates. Overall, the data highlights the program’s dedication to preparing graduates for professional success and improving licensure exam results over time.

The BSMARE program's management-level licensure exam results show different pass rates for first-time takers. The program performed well in 2020 and 2021, but the pass rate dropped in 2022 before improving slightly in 2023. The average pass rate for first-time examinees is 42.65%, showing a need to improve preparation and support. Retake examinees did better overall, with an average pass rate of 70.73%. They achieved a perfect pass rate in 2020 and high rates in 2021 and 2022, though it dropped to 69.23% in 2023. This drop shows some challenges but also highlights the

program's strong support for those retaking exams. Overall, these results show the program's efforts to help students succeed in both first-time and retake exams

1. Objectives of onboard training

- a. Ensure that during the required period of seagoing service the candidate receives systematic practical training and experience the duties of officers in charge.
- b. Is closely supervised by qualified deck officer
- c. Is adequately documented in the approved training record book

2. OBT Requirements 12 months or 36 months seagoing service.

The cadets while onboard shall be monitored by the STO in a monthly basis.

On completion of onboard training the cadet can now apply for BSMarE. Each cadet shall pass series of assessment in accordance with the policies and procedures of ZSCMST.

1. Written examination
2. Practical Assessment using appropriate laboratories
3. Panel Interview (oral assessment)

b. Analyzation of weaknesses in the licensure examination

The assessment method will allow the assessors to further evaluate the competencies and knowledge of cadets. The weaknesses can be determined and therefore advise the cadets to study in preparation of the MARINA board examination.

After series of examinations on different functions, students garnered lower assessment shall undergo enhancement activity such as consultation to review materials of specific skills.




d. Student Admission and Retention

Student General Retention Requirements

A student who qualifies for enrollment shall be eligible to stay for the entire period for which he/she is expected to complete his/her program of study in the MHEI, subject to compliance with retention policies without prejudice to his/her right to transfer to other MHEIs in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of the Commission,

except in the following cases:

- academic delinquency;
- violation of rules and regulations of the MHEI;
- failure to settle due tuition and other school fees, and other obligations;
- sickness or disease that would prevent the student to handle the pressures of school work or his continued presence thereat would be deleterious to other members of the academic community; and
- the closure of a program by the MHEI, or the closure of the MHEI itself.

STUDENT ADMISSION AND RETENTION

Section 31. Student General Admission Requirements

MHEI shall only accept students based on their respective carrying capacities, taking into account the number of facilities and equipment they own and faculty to student ratio. Students intending to enroll in the BSMT or BSMarE program shall comply with the minimum requirements for admission as follows:

31.1. Academic Qualifications: Senior High School graduate

31.2. Student Admission

The following shall be eligible for admission to the BSMT and BSMarE programs:

- a. A student who graduated from the secondary level of education, subject to satisfaction of the following requirements of the admitting institution:

- IQ Test;
 - Aptitude Test;
 - Personality Test;
 - Math, Science and English Tests; and
 - Physical and medical fitness test, pursuant to Regulation 1/9 of the STCW Convention 1978, as amended, to be conducted by a DOH accredited Medical Practitioner;
- b. A student who is transferring from an authorized maritime higher education institution, subject to completion/satisfaction of Physical and medical fitness test, pursuant to Regulation 1/9 of the STCW Convention 1978, as amended, to be conducted by a DOH accredited Medical Practitioner;
 - c. A student who is transferring from a maritime higher education institution whose programs are subjected to closure proceedings or are not authorized to be offered to a recognized MHEI, subject to completion/satisfaction of the following requirements:
 - Physical and medical fitness test, pursuant to Regulation 1/9 of the STCW Convention 1978, as amended, to be conducted by a DOH accredited Medical Practitioner;
 - Pass the written and practical assessment of prior learning (professional courses); retake failed courses in written and practical assessment;
 - d. A student who is transferring from an authorized maritime higher education institution whose admission standards requires new entrant on the First Year Level only, shall abide by the institution's admission policy; and
 - e. A student coming from outside the country must be evaluated in accordance with existing statutory and regulatory requirements prior to admission.

Assessment tool shall be developed by accepting MHEI guided by the procedures as stipulated in Annex E of this Circular.

Section 32. Physical and medical fitness requirements

In compliance with Regulation 1/9, Section A-1/9 of the STCW Convention, 1978, as amended, students enrolling in the BSMT and/or BSMarE program shall satisfy the following criteria to be considered physically and medically fit:

- a. have the physical capability to fulfill all the requirements of the basic training as required by Section A-VI/1, paragraph 2 of the STCW code;
- b. demonstrate adequate hearing and speech to detect any audible alarms and communicate effectively;
- c. have no medical condition, disorder or impairment that will prevent the effective and safe conduct of their routine and emergency duties on board the ship;
- d. not suffering from any medical condition likely to be aggravated by service at sea or to render the student unfit for such service; and
- e. adhere to the minimum in-service eyesight standards set out in Table A-1/9 of the STCW Code.

The College of Maritime Education Enrollment Flow

The enrollment process begins with a college admission test to assess academic readiness. Candidates then undergo aptitude and neurological assessments, followed by personal interviews that explore their goals and potential. Students are ranked based on their performance, and a medical check-up ensures they meet health requirements. After completing enrollment forms, successful applicants gain admission and access to campus resources. This systematic approach helps select students who are academically capable and well-suited to maritime education.

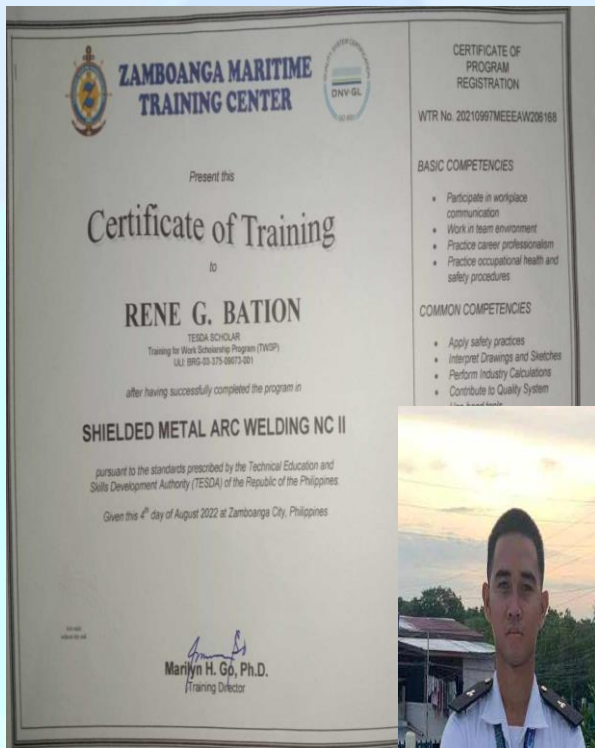


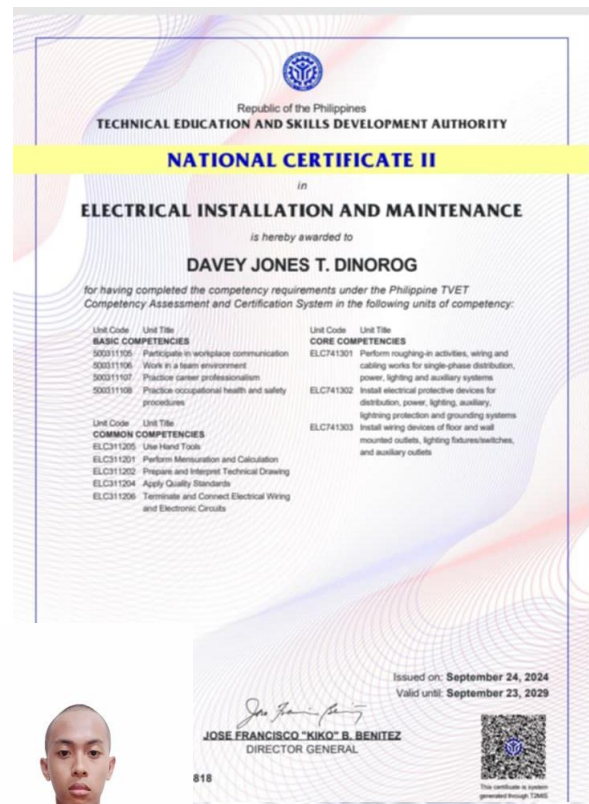
Mandatory Requirement 3:

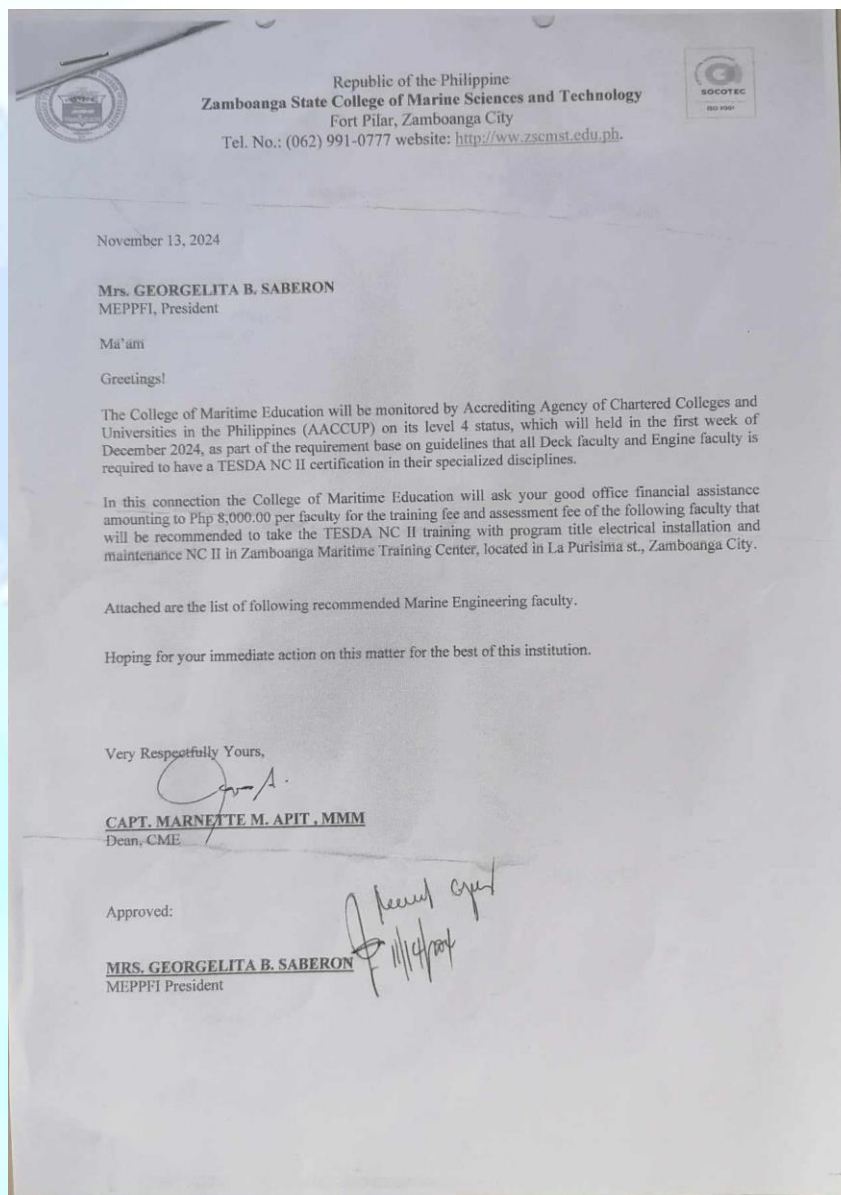




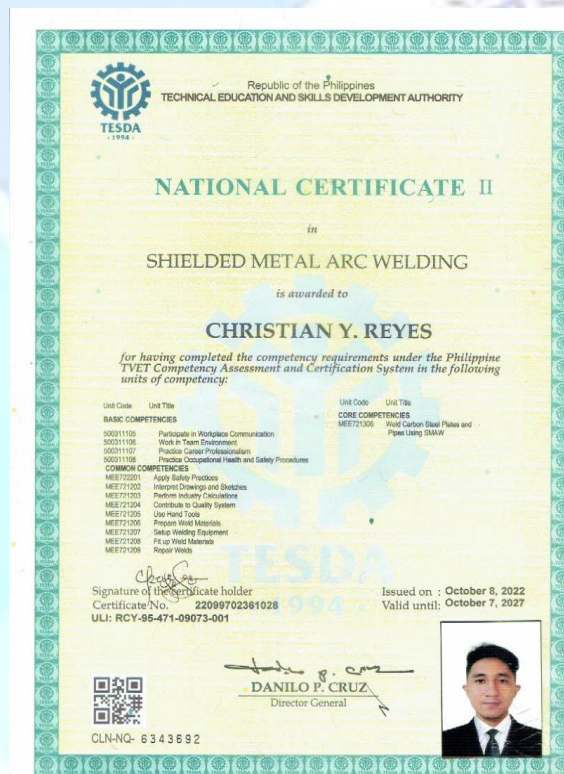
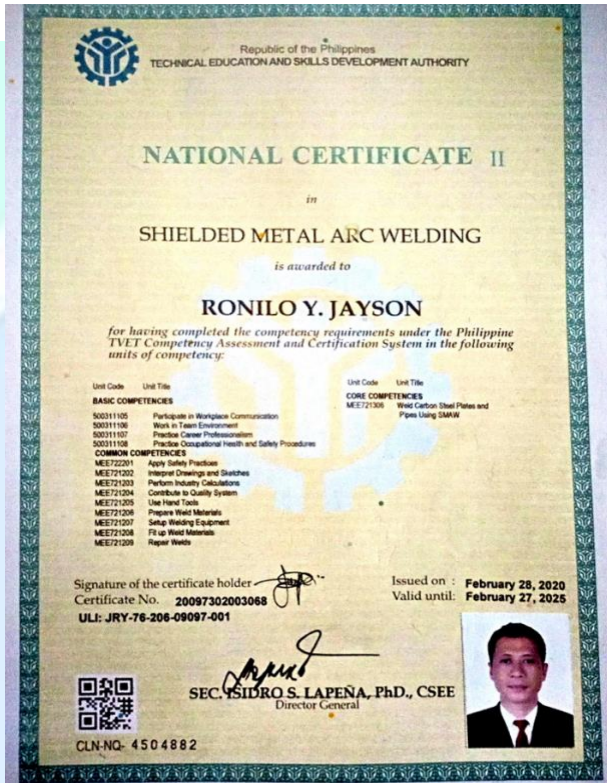
Mandatory Requirement 4:
